

Call for Undergraduate and Graduate Student Members Campus Writing Board

The Campus Writing Board (CWB) is seeking nominations for undergraduate and graduate students to serve as ex-officio members. Established in 1984, the CWB is a campus-wide faculty committee responsible for setting Campus Writing Program policies and approving courses as Writing Intensive (WI).

Student members serve on the Board to provide valuable student perspectives to discussions on WI courses. Faculty members serve three-year terms and review courses in one of three areas: Education and Social Sciences, Humanities and Arts, and Natural and Applied Sciences. The Board meets approximately four times per year to ensure WI courses align with the Guidelines for Writing Intensive Courses and maintain the integrity of the WI curriculum.

Nomination Process

Students must be nominated by a Campus Writing Board member, a WI course instructor, or Campus Writing Program staff.
